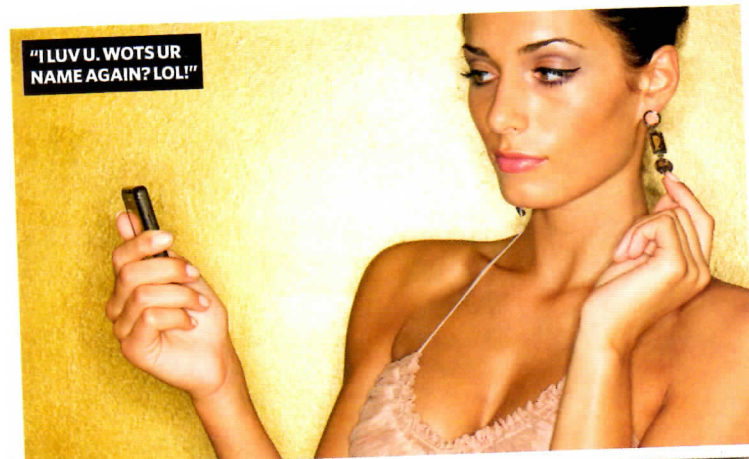
GET THE MESSAGE
